A 1920's cottage owned originally by the Pophanken family. Established as 'R.E. Pophanken's Store' by Robert Pophanken. Other business owner's were Fenton Schweke operating also as a General Store, and the John Kana family. Mr. Kana operated a tailor shop & cleaners at this Front Street Residence.

Mrs. Wilma Ziegenbein shared this history with me, as her family owned the large store behind us which was the "Kellner Store". She remembers the Pophanken's Store, and Fenton Schweke buying it later. She said her Mother would buy merchandise from Mr. Schweke to help out his smaller store during war times, 1940's Mr. Kana, the tailor, had business from all over the state to be fitted for suits. She & her mother had suits tailored by his shop.
