The Texan house has 2 bedrooms with queen size beds. The antiques beds are from the early 1900's and were David Schulz's great grandfather. The front room has a dresser which was from Bonnie Schulz's grandfather. Each bedroom has a private bathroom. The front bedroom has a cowboy tub with brass clawfeet and engraved "lone star". The pine bedroom has a queen size bed and a private bathroom with a double shower. The house can be rented per night.

The Lovely house was built in the early 1900's in New Ulm, Texas. The home has 2 bedrooms with each bedroom having a private bathroom. The bathrooms have clawfoot tubs and a corner shower for convivance. The bedrooms have queen size beds. The home has central air and heat. The home has a setting area, dining room, living room and a complete kitchen.

Most of the furniture was given to David Schulz from his great-grandfather, Christopher William Thielemann who settled in Welcome, Texas in 1866.
